- A commission of 20% for Guild members and 30% for non-members is taken; then divided between the Brighton Art Guild and Friends of the Brighton District Library to subsidize the costs of this program.
- Sales tax is not collected from the customer and is the responsibility of the artist.

AGREEMENT

- Submissions to the juror and AAL shall constitute an agreement to comply with all the conditions set forth in this entry form. We reserve the right to photograph and reproduce in any form the AAL entries for purposes of publicity and/or education.
- Juror reserves the right to select work deemed appropriate and suitable for viewing in this setting. Upon instillation, individual works may be omitted at the discretion of the AAL coordinator in conformance to AAL guidelines.

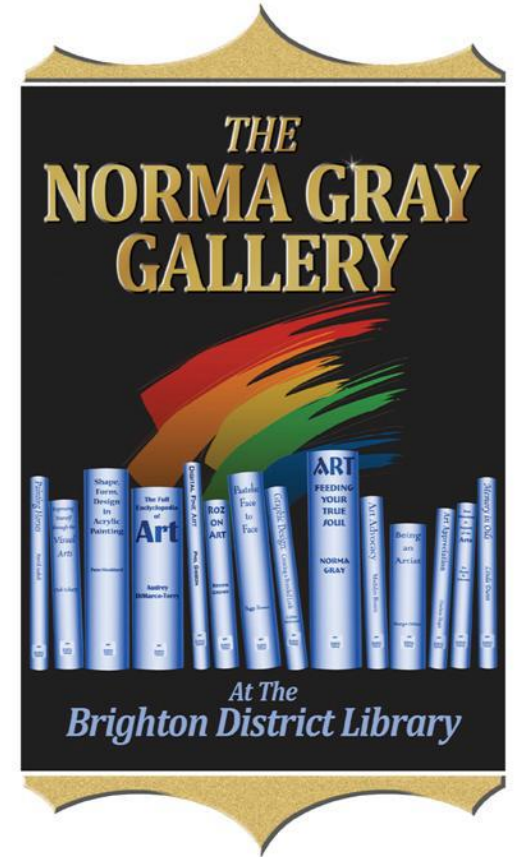

Administered by the Brighton Art Guild, The Norma Gray Gallery at the Brighton Library presents Art at the Library (AAL), a popular 'art in public places' program offered in cooperation with the Friends of the Brighton District Library.

The juried exhibitions feature two artists exhibiting together for six to eight weeks. The 2018 series will mark the 20th year for the AAL program. This venue was rededicated as the Norma Gray Gallery in December 2012 in honor of artist Norma Gray, one of the visionary founders of this exhibit as well as a founder of the Guild.

ELIGIBILITY

- Artists must be 18 years of age or older and a state of Michigan resident.
- All work must be original and created solely by the artist. If the work is created from photographs, they must be photographs taken by the artist.
- 2D and 3D applications are encouraged. Artists may exhibit in consecutive years only if medium/motif is obviously different in each year.

JURY FEE

\$20 jury fee for Brighton Art Guild members.
\$30 jury fee for non-members

- Jury fee is payable by check only and is non-refundable. Make checks payable to the Brighton Art Guild.
- Artists may submit two separate entries only if the medium/motif is obviously different in each.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

Entries must be postmarked no later than September 15, 2017

- Submit five images that represent a body of your work. All entries must be jpeg files on a DVD or memory stick (300 dpi, with one of the dimensions being 5").
- If you are a photographer willing to help artists with their submission jpgs, contact the Brighton Art Guild at: brightonartguild@gmail.com

Entry Procedures continued.....

- Artist's name should be on the DVD or memory stick with artwork title as the jpg file name (e.g., sunflowers.jpg). Any subsequent art display installed must significantly match the entry images in subject, style, media and/or motif.
- Enclose a self-addressed stamped standard business envelope (SASE) for each entry form. Your notification will be mailed back in this envelope. If desired, include a mailer with postage for the return of your DVD or memory sticks. The AAL program is not responsible for notification or return of submissions if postal materials are not provided.
- Artists who include the envelope described above will be notified of results in **October 2017**.

PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS

- Artists must transport and install their own art works. Guild members will direct and assist on-site. Artists must dismantle their own exhibit. No shipments are accepted.
- Upon intake, each work must be identified with the artist's name, title, media and price. The Guild will provide gallery cards.
- If juried into the AAL program, artist must install artworks according to AAL display criteria for a quality presentation.
- All works must fit into spaces provided on panels and in showcases. If you are unfamiliar with the venue, please contact John Wallbank.
- All works remain on display until the close of the exhibit.
